

Special Education: General Curriculum ADD-ON Coursework

For Fully Licensed Virginia Teachers

The Virginia Department of Education now offers Special Education: General Curriculum add-on endorsements with reduced coursework requirements for educators who already have endorsements in Elementary Education, Middle Education: 6-8, and Secondary teaching areas. **PLEASE NOTE:** in addition to the coursework below, the DOE requires 1 year of contractual teaching experience in special education to add a special education endorsement to a regular education teaching license.

SECONDARY: If you are a Virginia licensed teacher with a Secondary teaching endorsement in English, history & social sciences, math, biology, chemistry, Earth science or physics, you will need the following 5 courses	 EDU-L369* Foundations of Sp Ed: Legal Aspects & Characteristics EDU-L348 Instructional Strategies in Reading and Writing EDU-L383 IEP Implementation for Mild/Moderate Disabilities EDU-L400 Methods and Instructional Strategies in Math EDU-L455 Transitioning Students with Disabilities

*EDU-L369 is the one course you must have for a school division to be able to add the endorsement to your license provisionally.
